The University is a US-based university, founded in 1993. It offers bachelor's, master's, and PhD degrees in traditional and non-traditional (distance learning) education systems. The University provides professional programs certified by the University.

It consists of several faculties, including College of Business Administration, College of Education, College of Technology and Engineering, and College of Law, where the campus is located in the city of Irvine, in southern California.

Westcliff University adopts the latest standards of excellence and innovation in the development of its academic curricula and programs. It mainly focuses on enriching students with the scientific and practical skills necessary for the labor market, in conjunction with its main goal that is to graduate qualified students at the personal, academic, and professional levels.

Westcliff University is distinguished by the fact that its certificates are internationally accredited by accreditation and quality bodies including CHEA, WASC, ACBSP, and locally by Jordan's Ministry of Higher Education and Scientific Research.

Mechanism of Distance Learning Study at Westcliff University:

The University offers masters and PhD degrees through distance learning system for all those who want to pursue academic and professional development, specifically it is convenient for employees and workers who are bound by the condition of travel full-time academic commitment.

Study at the University is based on attending interactive lectures online delivered by professors through the University's flexible and modern technological systems, using easy-to-access technological platforms tailored specifically to the University students.

The academic year consists of (6) semesters, with (8) weeks for each semester separated by two months. The maximum limit for the registration of subjects is one subject, except for students who take remedial programs.

Study Language:

English language proficiency is necessary for admission to the programs by fulfilling one of the following conditions:

(TOEFL iBT) Certificate with a score of 79, or (IELTS) with a score of 6.5, valid for two years.

Or, an official letter issued from the student's university for the last stage of their education, confirming that English is the language of study for the full program.

Or, English language level (CPE) exam with a (B2 +) score.

If one of the aforementioned conditions is not met, the student will need to enroll in the University's REAL language program (CPE). Such students will need to take an exam that will determine the duration of language study required, with an exam fee of \$50

Exams:

These exams are carried out in the form of assignments, projects, and exams conducted digitally through the University's online platform and under the direct supervision of the University.

Marks and Scores:

The University adopts a point grading system (4.00 points), and displays the marks of subjects with symbols according to the points shown in the table:














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
