‘Abu-Ghazaleh Global’ and the Arab Industrial Development, Standardization & Mining Organization Sign Cooperation Agreement



AMMAN – Talal Abu-Ghazaleh Global (TAG. Global) and the Arab Industrial Development, Standardization & Mining Organization (AIDSMO) signed a cooperation agreement in industry and technology fields, at the opening of the 60th session of the AIDSMO Executive Board.

The agreement covers cooperation and coordination in technical support, expertise exchange, technical consulting and knowledge-sharing. It also aims at promoting innovation, creative and information technology as well as raising awareness in the areas of industry, standardization and mining. At the opening of the 60th session, HE Dr. Talal Abu-
